- Narrative and Biographical Statement of the nominee which reference AIA membership and activities, relevant volunteer and community services work, other awards and recognitions as well as professional and technical excellence. Maximum 1000 words.
- A Letter of support, but not more than three (3) - 1 page each
- Up to three (3) exhibits (maximum of two pages each) with images, drawings, or other materials that demonstrate the candidate's accomplishments.
- Other information supporting the nominee may be submitted.

Additionally, please submit one black & white photograph of the nominee in a separate electronic file (jpeg format preferred).
